Reading Old Cemetery

Within the CWGC Enclosure located to the far south-east of the cemetery is a memorial listing the names of those who are buried elsewhere in the cemetery but have no headstones. A Screen Wall Memorial commemorates those buried in Plot 72. There are 205 Commonwealth burials of the 1914-1918 war and 41 of the 1939-1945 war. There is also 1 Serbian burial.
