Braywood

Braywood is a hamlet adjacent to Fifield and Oakley Green. The church used to be All Saints, located at New Lodge (SU912/750). The church was demolished in and replaced by a small chapel on the site of Braywood cemetery (WM4037) which remains and is the site of one WW1 grave to Athur George Harvey (19452 in the Royal Berks Regt) who died 4/1/1916. The CWGC wrongly ascribe the cemetery in which he is buried to the modern Oakley Green Cemetery located on the A308. The memorials from All Saints were removed and located at Braywood Memorial Hall at the junction of Fifield Road and the B3024. (SU909/764)
